

West River Community Center Date Night Waiver



It is our goal to provide a safe and welcoming environment to all children placed in our care. There are some things however, that are out of our control that we need your cooperation with. Here are some reminders to you as a parent to help us accomplish our goal.

- Your kids can enjoy a night out at the WRCC. Our younger participants (18 month – 4 years) will have the opportunity to play in our daycare, indoor playground, and MAC Gym. The older kids (5 – 12 years) will have access to our amenities such as the basketball courts, climbing wall, tennis/racquetball courts and more (dependent upon enrollment). **Swimming pool will only be available on designated future dates.*
- All participants will be supervised by WRCC staff, while they participate in athletics, arts and crafts or board games. Pizza and refreshments will be provided.
- Parents must register each child for the session date they wish to participate in. Each month, your first child's registration is \$20 and each additional child receives a \$5 discount.
- Refunds are only permitted for special circumstances and will be handled on a case by case basis.
- Please make sure that your child has a dry diaper on or has used the restroom facilities in the lobby area before being checked into the childcare. There is a restroom for children in our daycare area that staff and participants will utilize during the evening.
- The drop-in daycare is not a licensed daycare, however since parents are leaving the facility, our staff will change diapers as needed.
- Please bring the essentials for your child. Diapers, bottles, snacks or anything your child may need during their time in our care. We DO NOT provide diapers, bottles, snacks or other childcare items.
- We reserve the right to decline services to any child that is sick or is running a fever.
- All children must have dry clothes and socks on in the facility.
- Children are NOT ALLOWED to bring in outside toys or electronic items, we are not responsible for lost, broken or stolen items.
- Bullying or any unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated. You will be called to the Community Center and asked to remove your child if such instance occurs. Repeated problems will dictate loss of childcare privileges.
- If extreme accident/incident occurs, you will be asked to immediately return to the facility.
- Late pickup may result in additional fees or future loss of date night event privileges.
