

COVID-19 PROCEDURES AND PHYSICAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES

The following are a set of guidelines for operational practices at the Patterson Lake Recreation Area & Campground. These guidelines have been created with the knowledge and information from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and local health officials. We are continuing to monitor the impact of COVID-19 as it relates to our campground operations, which could lead to altering or ceasing operations at any time. The health and safety of our campground users and employees, is our number one priority!

Reservations

1. Reservations can be made in advance. Call 701-456-2074 or visit our website www.dickinsonparks.org to make a reservation. Credit or Debit Cards only for payments made over the phone or online.
2. If registering on-site, stop by the Informational Booth to complete reservation.
3. If Informational Booth is closed, fill out the registration form and place with payment, in the deposit box.
4. Use good judgement when following travel guidelines and restrictions.
5. Stay home if you are sick or symptomatic.

Arrival

1. The Informational Booth is open M-TH 11:00am-6:00pm, Fri 11:00am-7:00pm, and Sat/Sun 10:00am-7:00pm.
2. Upon arrival, check-in at the Booth then proceed to your designated prepaid camping site.
3. We have increased the frequency of cleaning and sanitizing practices, however it is recommended that each camper takes additional responsibility in cleaning their own site and common surface areas.

Sites

1. Camping is only allowed in designated sites.
2. Sites will include water and electrical hook ups, use of the dump station and fire pit ring, and access to the restrooms/shower house.
3. Only members of the same household are allowed in the campsite.
4. No outside visitors allowed in the campground.
5. Stay in your campsite. Do not mingle in other sites.

Restrooms/Shower House

1. All campground users will have access to the restrooms/shower house.
2. Only one person should be in the restroom at a time. Multiple members from the same household or parents with young children are the only exception.
3. Please be respectful and expedite restroom/shower house use, as others may be waiting outside.

Park

1. All surfaces that will be touched should be cleaned and/or covered before and after use. Plastic table coverings are recommended.
2. Campground users are still encouraged to use the Crooked Crane Trail, while practicing safe social distancing.

Intentional or deliberate failure to abide by these rules are subject to removal from the campground without a refund.
